WHAT IS A FUSION LANDSCAPE PROFESSIONAL



FUSION LANDSCAPE

Elements

1	BIOSWALE	Bioswales are designed to mimic the water cycle by using plants to naturally filter rainwater as it slowly seeps into the ground.
2	DOWNSPOUT DISCONNECTION	Downspout disconnection is the process of separating a downspout from the stormwater sewer system and re-directing it to another location such as a lawn or garden. If a downspout goes straight into the ground, it is likely connected to the storm sewer.
3	DRAINAGE CHANNEL	A natural way to direct the flow of water on your property.
4	DRY CREEK	A dry creek imitates the look of a stream bed, without the water. They can be used as a functional landscape feature, to redirect water or help with drainage issues, or they can be added to the landscape for aesthetic reasons only.
5	INFILTRATION PIT	A landscape area filled with gravel, designed to allow water to quickly seep into the ground.
6	LAWN AND LAWN ALTERNATIVES	For a healthy lawn, grass seed that is high in fescue content and low in Kentucky Blue content is best. Alternatives to traditional grass lawns are also available that are drought tolerant and require less fertilizer than traditional lawns.
7	PERMEABLE PAVEMENT	Pavement made of porous materials that allows for rainwater and air to move freely through and into the soil, reducing the amount of runoff from your property.
8	RAIN CHAIN	Rain chains can be used in place of traditional downspouts to direct water where you need it while adding an artistic touch.

9	RAIN BARREL	Rain barrels are used to capture rainwater from downspouts that can be used later. There are many different varieties available to suit your style, ranging from simple to decorative.
10	RAIN GARDEN	Rain gardens and infiltration areas can be created to fit any style and are an attractive addition to your landscape. Rainwater from downspouts is directed to the rain garden and soaks into the ground slowly instead of being directed to the storm sewer.
11	RIGHT PLANT, RIGHT PLACE	Matching a plants needs to the conditions that it will be growing in will help plants thrive and look their best. Always check plant tags before you buy to be sure there is an appropriate spot in your garden for them.
12	SCREE GARDEN	A scree garden, also known as a rock, gravel or alpine garden, is a garden that uses a mass of loose stones and soil as the growing medium which allows alpine plants to grow.
13	SMART CONTROLLER	An irrigation controller that uses weather inputs to make automatic scheduling adjustments to an irrigation system. Contact a Water Smart Irrigation Professional to learn more. Visit watersmartirrigationprofessional.ca
14	SOAKAWAY PIT	Soakaway pits are small underground reservoirs below the surface and help to slow the flow of water on your property. This feature will not be visible on the surface of your property but will help to reduce the impacts of flooding.
15	TREATMENT TRAIN	A sequence of two or more Fusion elements designed to capture, move, clean, and re-use water.
